### Donation Requests

**Foundation classes:** Sweets, biscuits and mince pies. They must be wrapped for hygiene reasons and in date. Ideal example are the small bags of Haribo sweets or similar.



**Year 1 & Year 2 classes:** Items for the secrets room. The secrets room is a room where the children can choose a present and wrap it for a friend or relative to give at Christmas. No parents or carers are allowed in this room and it is manned by the



teachers who help the children. This activity is very popular with the children. We are asking for donations of items that parents / grandparents / siblings etc would like to receive on the big day! (e.g socks, sweets, toiletries, toys, etc). See pictures for further ideas.

**ALL years: we are also asking for filled jam jars** ("whatever is that," I hear you ask?)

We would like to have two stalls of Jam jars. This is a raffle type activity. A raffle ticket is purchased and a 5 or a 0 is needed to win a filled jam jar of your choice. Example items that you can fill your jam jar with are small 'penny' toys, bracelets, cars, sweets (wrapped please), rubbers, hair bits, lego etc. See picture for ideas. These always sell out so please feel free to bring in as many jars or containers as you wish. If you do not have a jar to fill then any clear container will do – such as plastic disposable cups for parties. Please make sure that your container is covered (can be cling film/cut up cloth/foil etc).
