Friday - Division Word Problems

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Can you use your knowledge of dividing to solve the word problems below? Remember to write the number sentence and show your working out!

James has 6 bread rolls. He shares them equally between his 2 friends. How many do they have each?

A shop has 15 bags of crisps. 3 people want to buy them. If they share how many bags can they each buy?

The teacher buys 30 cupcakes. She shares them equally between her 10 children. How many cupcakes do they each have?

Mark buys 15 boxes of cereal for his family. They share them equally and each get 3 boxes. How many people are in his family?

Erin collects 21 shells. She shares them between 3 fishermen. How many shells do they each get? Try the extension challenge on the challenges sheet if you would like an extra challenge!

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
