<u>READING AT HOME</u>—please can I remind all parents to listen to their children read at least 5 times a week. Even if the books are picture books please discuss and talk about the pictures and what is happening and predicting what might happen next. Research shows that children who read and share books regularly at home are successful when they are older.

<u>OUTSIDE SCHOOL EQUIPMENT</u>—please remember that no-one is allowed on the school play equipment before or after school. Our insurance is only valid if a member of staff is supervising. Can I ask that all parents have their children standing next to them in the mornings whilst they are waiting to go into school and also to hold an adults hands when leaving the school ground. I appreciate the climbing frames are a temptation but the children have also been told that they should not be on them.
