In the secrets room the children can choose a present and wrap it for Christmas day. No parents are allowed in this room and it is manned by the teachers who help the children. 1) Please donate filled jam jars (whatever is that I hear you ask?)

We hold 2 stalls of Jam jars which is a tombola/raffle kind of stall. Example items that you can fill your jam jar with are small 'penny' toys, bracelets, cars, sweets (wrapped please), rubbers, hair bits, shopkins, lego etc. See picture or examples in reception for ideas. You may donate as few or as many as you want to and any clear container is fine so long as it has been thoroughly washed. Please make sure that your container is covered with maybe cling film or cut up festive paper or cloth.



2) Please donate clean/washed unwanted cuddle toys, unwanted presents or new items that you will never use and any spare wrapping paper.
