

Dear Parents and Carers,

The weather seems to have changed yet again but I hope everyone has been enjoying the slightly relaxed Covid rules. Unfortunately, due to the government announcement on Monday we are having to slightly alter some of our end of term plans. Please see the diary dates for more information.

Year 2 Open Afternoon Tuesday 22nd June 2:30-2:50pm

This will now be fully outside and weather dependent (one adult per child with a face mask & no young siblings). If the weather is looking bad a last minute cancellation will happen and we will contact you via email/SchoolPing.

Year 1 Open Afternoon Thursday 24th June 2:30-2:50pm

As above, this will now be fully outside and weather dependent (one adult per child with a face mask & no young siblings).

EYFS Open Afternoon Monday 28th June 2:00-2:40pm

Again, this will be outside and due to the large number of parents attending (one adult per child with a face mask & no young siblings) we will need more time for organisation. Topaz parents will be in the main playground and Ruby parents will be in the EYFS garden area. This will be fully outside and weather dependent. At 2:40pm, at the end of the session children will return to class briefly to collect their bags and then they will be able to go straight home with their adult rather than having to go and line up again and wait.

IN ALL CASES, IF THE WEATHER FORECAST IS LOOKING RAINY THEN THERE WILL BE LAST MINUTE CANCELLATIONS. PLEASE LOOK OUT FOR OUR EMAILS OR ON YOUR SCHOOLPING APP.

FOR ALL EVENTS PARENTS WILL BE ASKED TO SIGN IN AGAINST THEIR CHILD'S NAME TO ENSURE WE ONLY HAVE 30 PARENTS EACH TIME TO KEEP WITH THE COVID GOVERNMENT RULES

Year 2 Mini Olympics

Last summer our Year 2 children missed out on taking part in our annual Mini Games Competition so this year it has been arranged by the Schools Sports Partnership for as many Year 2 children in Chelmsford schools to participate in a **Mini Games Virtual Competition** on all the different school sites, this summer term.

On Thursday the 10th June, all our Year 2 children took part in this event and had to carryout 6 different set activities, these were:

- 1, **Ladder station: Timed activity**
- 2, **Beanie station: Timed activity**
- 3, **Sprint station: Timed activity**
- 4, **Throw for distance station**
- 5, **Speed stacks station: Timed activity**
- 6, **Jumping station: Timed activity**

All of the children had a fantastic time and the staff completed their individual score cards at each activity. These score cards have now been sent off to the Schools Sports Partnership where they will be added together and compared against the other schools. Schools will then be informed of which school had the highest score and came first, which boy overall had the highest score and which girl overall had the highest score etc. We are currently waiting for all the scores to be collected in and compared and the final results to be sent. Once we have these results we will let you know.
