### Parents Evening

Parents evening time slots went out to parents on Monday. Please remember to sign up to a 10 minute meeting with the class teacher. Please can I ask that everyone arrives at least five minutes before their chosen time to enable you to look at your children's work beforehand. Also, if you have more than one child in school, please allow at least 20 minutes between appointment times in case of any delays. There is only space for one parents evening slot per child due to time constraints, so we ask that parents come together or if this is not possible for various reasons to alternate parents evenings over the year. During the spring meetings the teachers will give parents a target card to show what their next steps are. Of course, I will be at hand to move people along to ensure we do not over run.

## Teacher Clubs

After half term the teachers are looking forward to starting their KS1 clubs on Tuesday 24th February. This is just to give the children a flavour of the different experiences and skills that they may wish to develop further. The children have selected their clubs and everyone should now have the letter confirming which club they will be attending. Clubs finish at 4pm and the teachers will see them out of the door indicated on the letter. Please can I ask parents/carers who are picking up from the clubs to make themselves known to the teacher as they will not necessarily be their current class teacher and they may not recognise you. Teacher clubs will be available in the summer term to both EYFS and KS1 pupils.
