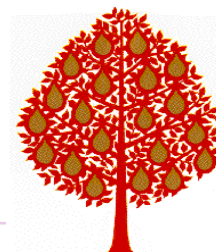

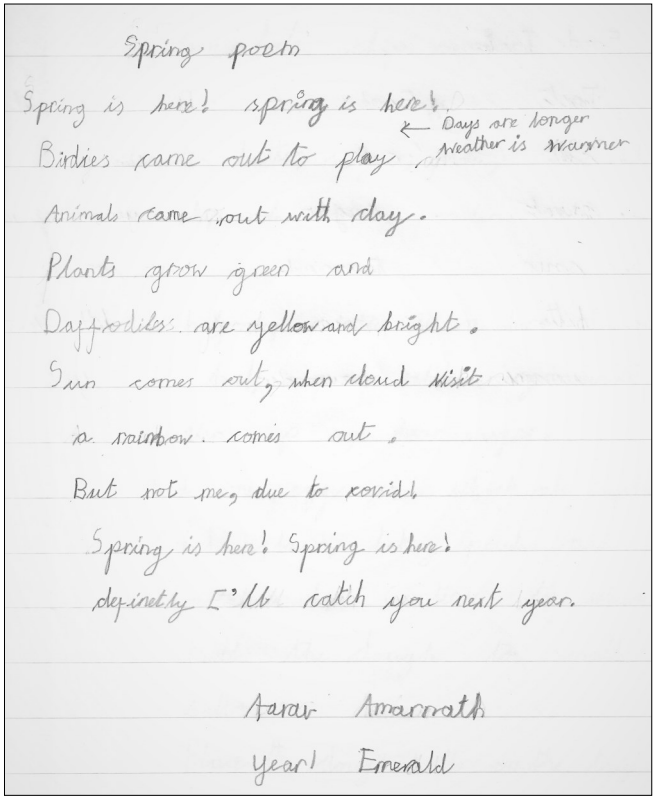

 Spring is a wonderful thing

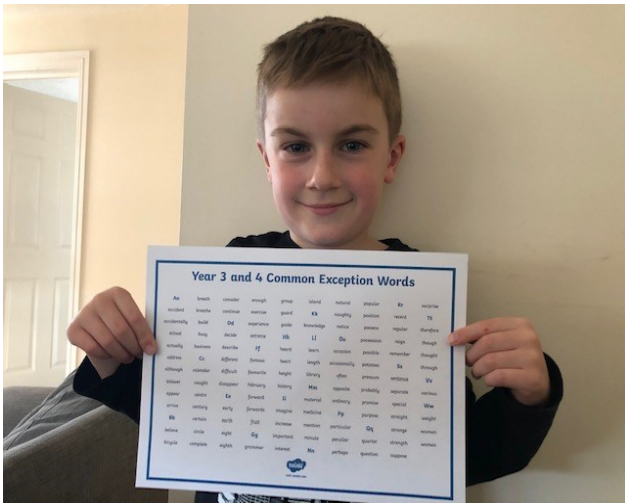
Fluttering butterflies and hatching chicks,

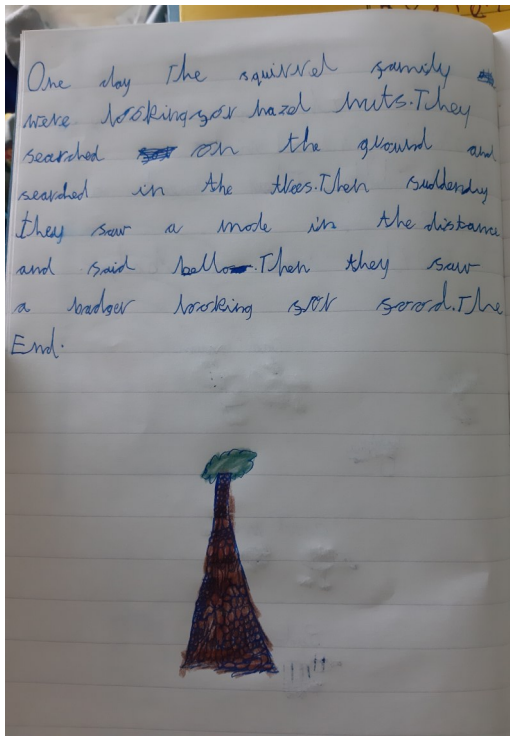
