THURSDAY 16TH JUNE—(A message from the FIPS Team) The circus and the Fete are fast approaching, with less than a week to go! The fete will be on the school field from the end of the school day until the opening of the Big Top at 5.15pm. Then the Circus will run from 5.30- 7.30pm (with a 30min interval). Remember you don't need Circus tickets to come and have fun at the Fete.

The games stalls will be at a cost of 50p, £1 or £2 and the FIPS Snack Station selling drinks, crisps, donuts & ice creams will be 50p or £1 so please ensure that you bring plenty of change to enjoy some yummy treats before the Circus or in the interval. There will also be a Pizza van and a Burger Van so dinner is sorted too.
