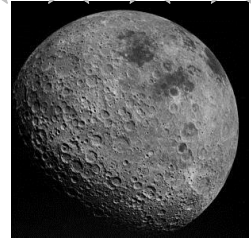




# Diamond Class' Trip to the Moon
