Mrs Champion has spent time creating some fantastic parent resources to enable you to feel more confident in supporting your child with their handwriting and maths.

Here at Perryfields Infant School we have a special 'Upstroke' handwriting style that we teach the children from the Foundation Stage. The reason for this is that it supports children to join up in Year 2 and develop their writing stamina. Mrs Champion has placed some short simple handwriting videos to help support everyone to see how specific letters are taught in school.

There are also some maths videos explaining how to support adding and subtracting using various methods e.g. column method, blank number line, sticks and dots and part-whole model.
