# School Re-opening

On Monday, I am sure you were optimistically watching the Prime Minister's official announcement to reveal his important lockdown exit "roadmap". The plan outlined how the country will steadily come out of lockdown restrictions over the next few months.

As you are aware, schools have remained open throughout the third lockdown to the children of key workers and vulnerable children. Staff have continued to provide remote education to everyone else who has been learning at home. In addition, we have continued to plan on how we will re-open the school for all children when allowed.

Schools have now been given the green light for all children to return on the 8th March. We will shortly be providing you with more information regarding this including staggered start and finish times and also the one way system. It is wonderful that so many people have already received the vaccination, this however doesn't mean that we don't have to social distance any more. Please can I ask everyone to continue to keep the 2 metres distancing rules and wear their face masks when coming onto the school premises. We will continue with all our normal safeguarding measures including enhanced cleaning, ventilation, additional hand washing, limiting movement around the school, teacher's desks distanced from children, staggered lunch and break times, remaining in class bubbles etc and will continue to follow the DFE guidelines.
