

Writing a winter list poem

Look at the poem below. It is called a list poem because it is really just a list of nouns with adjectives to describe them.

We Love Autumn

Crunchy, golden leaves,
Shiny, bright red berries,
Gusty, howling wind,
Pouring, puddling rain,
Dark, chilly nights,
Happy, laughing children,
We love Autumn!

Now generate your own list of nouns associated with either winter or Christmas. You could write them on red slips of paper or in red pen. Then for each noun, think of one or two adjectives to describe it. You could write them in green pen or on green paper.

Decide on the order.

Choose your final line (We love winter! or We love Christmas! or something similar.)

Write your poem out neatly and decorate it with some of the things you mentioned in the poem.

Perform it to your family!
