

## *A few reminders.....*

**A change in the weather**—the nights are drawing in and the weather has definitely started to get colder. Please can all children bring a NAMED coat into school with them and as we get closer to winter NAMED hats and gloves.

**Water Bottles**—all water bottles **MUST** have a clear name label on it. Please do not rely on your child with remembering which bottle is their one. Lots of these bottles all look the same. Please remember to use the plastic bottles (**NO METAL WATER BOTTLES**) as metal bottles are extremely noisy in class, do not pour correctly and when they accidentally tip over will go everywhere.

**Reading Workshop**—don't forget that Mrs Fairbanks our Literacy Lead teacher will be leading a parents phonic/reading workshop this Tuesday 5th October at 9:15am. Unfortunately, we are unable to hold these in the evening due to teacher workload but these resources and PowerPoint will be uploaded to our school website after the event for everyone to access.
