Admissions

It is that time of year again when parents will be making their decisions on their child's Reception school place for September 2020. If this is you, please can I remind you of the application deadline date of 15th January 2020. The admissions website can be located on www.essex.gov.uk/admissions.

CURRENT YEAR 2 PARENTS—Just as above the current year 2 parents need to make an application to the junior school via the same admissions website to Essex County Council. This is a similar application where you have to state which school you would like your child to attend in September 2020. Historically all children have automatically attended the junior school. Last year the government made some changes to this process which means that all current Year 2 parents MUST make a formal application. Please complete this application between 11th November to 15th January 2020. The advice previously given from the Admissions team is to ensure the application is NOT LATE and that you only have to name one school. Please do this as soon as possible.
