PE	Ball skills Hitting, throwing, rolling, catching, passing, working as a team.	Dance Interpreting music, Learning and performing a sequence of actions.
Music	Duration Making and controlling sounds of different length	Pulse and rhythm Creating and performing patterns of sound.
RE/PSHE	Relationships – democratic decisions, creating and following rules, recognising feelings.	Relationships - fair and unfair, kind and unkind, taking turns, co-operating with others
	Special people – why I am special, Jesus, special people in Judaism. Harvest.	Special stories – my own special stories, the Bible, stories from Hinduism. Christmas
