I can report that we currently have no known cases of COVID-19 at school. If a child/member of staff has Covid symptoms:

- They must be kept off school and self isolate for 10 days (or at such point as they get a negative test in that window)
- All other members of the household need to self isolate for 14 days.
 They can only come out of isolation if the symptomatic person tests negative
- The symptomatic child/member of staff cannot come into school for 10 days (or until such time as they secure a negative test and show evidence of this)
- If child/member of staff tests positive we will contact PHE

See Hear Respond Service

This is a new service aimed at children who are not receiving support or who have not met thresholds but, because of COVID-19 and wider problems, are struggling. They and their families would benefit from some immediate help in the short term.

The aim is to provide short term wrap around support to help de-escalate issues and support children with re-integration into education and agencies where their support needs can be met in the longer term.

The support will be delivered both by Barnardo's services and other national and local delivery partners who have been assessed in terms of suitability to provide support. These partners include large charities such as The Children's Society and Action for Children and smaller local charities who are well respected in communities.

We have recently been informed that there has been a video appear over the last few days which has gone viral which is inappropriate for children. TikTok (formerly called Musical.ly) is a social media platform that lets you create, share and discover 15 second videos. The official age rating for TikTok is aged 16+. 
