The Hermit Crab

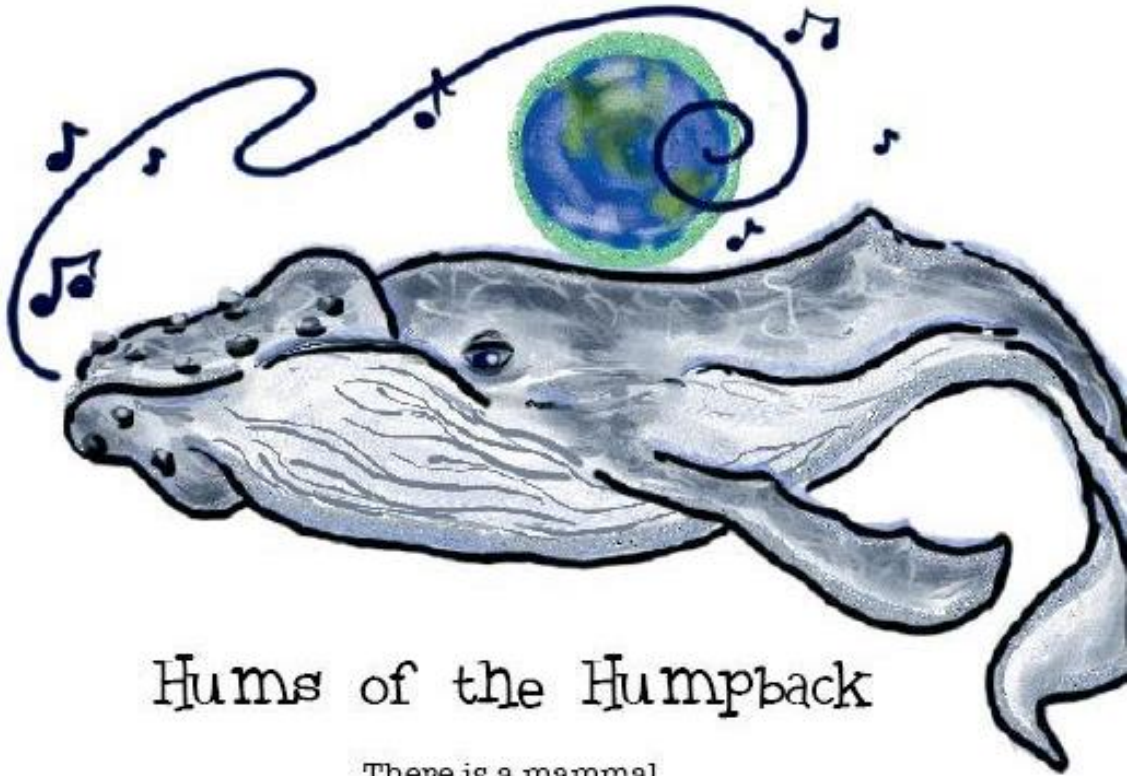


The hermit crab
